The Gospel concerns the PERSON JESUS CHRIST (Not a name, an idea, a concept, a worldview)






Abel, a type of Christ. Righteous and slain by his brother (Matt. 23:35)








Seth: God's Appointed Seed



The Skull Crushing Line of Seth




Genesis 4:25,26

Seth, a type of Christ. God has appointed a new life in place of an old dead one.










Noah the Rest Giver




Genesis 5:28,29

God Dwells in the Tents of Shem




Genesis 9:26,27


26 "Blessed be the Lord, the God of Shem and let Canaan be his servant.
27 'May God enlarge Japheth, and let Him dwell in the tents of Shem and let Canaan be his servant."


John 1:14 "And the Word became flesh, and dwelt [lit. 'tented' or 'tabernacled'] among us...."

Shem, a type of Christ. God Himself will "dwell in the tents" (lineage) of Shem.










A Nation to Bring Global Blessings



Genesis


12:1-3

"Now the Lord said to Abram,'Go forth from your country, and from your relatives and from your father's house, to the land which I will show you. 2 And I will make you a <u>great nation</u>, and I will bless you and make your name great. And so you shall be a blessing. 3 And I will bless those who <u>bless you</u>, and the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

Abraham, a type of Christ. God creates a people from one Man through whom all nations will be blessed.



Isaac Inherits the Abrahamic Blessing




Genesis 17:18,19

18 "And Abraham said to God, "Oh that Ishmael might live before You!" 19 But God said, 'No, but Sarah your wife will bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; and I will establish My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant for his descendants after him.""

Isaac, a type of Christ. God promises and provides a son and covenant heir.

Genesis 28:13-15


13 "And behold, the LORD stood above [the ladder] and said, 'I am the LORD, the God of your father Abraham and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie, I will give it to you and to your descendants. 14 Your descendants will also be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south; and in you and in your descendants shall all the families of the <u>earth be blessed</u>. 15 Behold, <u>I am with you</u> and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you."

Jacob ("Israel"), a type of Christ. God promises His heir numberless offspring, protection, and to bring His people back from exile.



The Kingship Comes from Judah








Genesis 49:9,10


*From the verb שלה (shala),

The Seed of Jesse of Bethlehem will be King




1 Samuel 16:1b "I will send you to Jesse the Bethlehemite, for I have selected a king for Myself among his sons."

The Eternal Kingdom from the House of David




2 Samuel 7:16 "Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever."










1 Samuel 17:12a "Now David was the son of the Ephrathite of Bethlehem in Judah, whose name was Jesse, and he had eight sons."

The King of Kings from the Stem of Jesse

Isaiah 11:1-5 "Then a shoot will spring from the stem of Jesse, and a branch from his roots will bear fruit. 2 The Spirit of the LORD will rest on Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD. 3 And He will delight in the fear of the LORD, and He will not judge by what His eyes see, nor make a decision by what His ears hear. 4 But with righteousness He will judge the poor, and decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth. And He will strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He will slay the wicked. 5 Also righteousness will be the belt about His loins, and faithfulness the belt about His waist."

Isaiah 11:10 "Then in that day, the nations will resort to the <u>root of Jesse</u>, who will stand as a signal for the peoples, and His resting place will be glorious."


The Everlasting King on David's Throne

Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the LORD Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel ['God with us']."

Isaiah 9:6,7 "For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us. And the government will rest on His shoulders, and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. 7 There will be no end to the increase of His government nor of peace, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of Hosts will accomplish this."

Gospel Promises In the Seed Line Passages

- 1. The seed of the Woman will "strike" the head of the serpent (Genesis 3:15)
- 2. God "appoints offspring" to be the Skull Crushing Seed, despite Mankind's Exile (Genesis 4:25)
- 3. After Seth, exiled men begin to "call upon the name of the LORD" (Genesis 4:26)
- 4. Noah will "give rest" to Mankind's labor (Genesis 5:29)
- 5. God will "dwell in the tents (lineage) of Shem" (Genesis 9:27)
- 6. God will make from "Abraham a great nation" (Genesis 12:2)
- 7. God will "bless all people" through Abraham's descendants (Genesis 12:3)
- 8. God will establish "everlasting covenant" with Abraham (Genesis 17:19)
- 9. The number of Abraham's descendents will be like "dust of the earth" (Genesis 28:14)
- 10. God promises to "<u>accompany and keep Abraham wherever he goes</u>" (Genesis 28:15)
- 11. The "scepter" belonging to "Shiloh" will bring "obedience of the peoples [nations]" (Genesis 49:9,10)
- 12. God has "<u>selected a king for Himself</u>" (1 Samuel 16:1)
- 13. "From the clan of Bethelehem Ephrathah will go forth a ruler in Israel for the LORD" (Micah 5:2)
- 14. "David's house and kingdom shall endure before God forever" (2 Samuel 7:16)
- 15. <mark>Spirit of LORD upon Jesse's heir: wisdom, counsel, understanding, righteousness</mark> (Isaiah 11:2)
- 16. <u>A virgin will bear a son</u>, "<u>Immanuel</u>", called "<u>Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father,</u>

 <u>Prince of Peace</u>" whose <u>eternal Davidic rule</u> brings <u>ever-increasing worldwide justice</u> (Isaiah 11:2)



Jesus Fulfills All Gospel Promises

- 1. Jesus "crushes" the serpent (Romans 16:20; Revelation 20)
- 2. God "appointed" Christ as universal heir (Luke 2:24; Hebrews 3:2)
- 3. Men to "call upon Jesus" for salvation (Acts 2:21, 4:12; Romans 10:13; 2 Timothy 2:19)
- 4. Jesus gives "rest" to Mankind (Matthew 11:28-30; Hebrews 4:1-11)
- 5. Jesus is the eternal Word made flesh who "tabernacled among us" (John 1:14)
- 6. God has formed "<u>a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation</u>" from Jesus (1 Peter 2:9)
- 7. God gives us every spiritual "blessing" in Christ (Matthew 5:3-11; Acts 3:26; Ephesians 1:3)
- 8. God established an "eternal covenant" through Jesus (2 Corinthians 3:6; Hebrews 13:20)
- 9. A great multitude that no one could number worships Christ as LORD (Revelation 7:9)
- 10. Jesus promises to <u>never leave his sheep</u> (Matthew 28:20; Luke 15:4; 19:10)
- 11. Jesus' obedience brings righteousness to many (Romans 1:4,5; 5:19; Hebrews 5:9; 1 Peter 1:2)
- 12. God selected Jesus as King and heir over all things (Luke 1:32,33; Hebrews 1:2-8)
- 13. Jesus born in **Bethlehem** as **ruler** (Matthew 2:6; Luke 2:4,11; John 7:42)
- 14. Jesus sits on <u>throne of David</u>, reigning over an <u>eternal kingdom</u> (Luke 1:32-33; Hebrews 1:8)
- 15. The Holy Spirit of righteousness rests upon Jesus (John 1:32-33; Ephesians 1:17; 1 Corinthians 1:30)
- 16. Jesus was <u>born of a virgin, God incarnate, King of Kings</u>, who dwells among us (<u>Immanuel</u>) and whose <u>spirit lives in us</u> (Matthew 1:23; John 1:1-18; Romans 8:9; Ephesians 2:14-18; Hebrews 13:20; Revelation 17:14; 19:16)


