JESUS CHRIST
(5 BC - 33 AD)

The King's Lineal Right to Rule

Matthew 1:1 "The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham"

Matthew 1:16-18 "Jacob was the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, by whom Jesus was born, **who is called the Messiah**. **17** So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; from David to the deportation to Babylon, fourteen generations; and from the deportation to Babylon to the Messiah, fourteen generations. **18** Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah was as follows: when **His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph**, before they came together she was found to be with **child by the Holy Spirit**."

Mark 1:1 "The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Messiah, the Son of God."

The Gospel in the Genealogy of the King

Luke 1:26–33 “Now in the sixth month the **angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city in Galilee called Nazareth, 27** to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was **Joseph, of the descendants of David; and the virgin’s name was Mary. 28** And coming in, he said to her, “Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you.” **29** But she was very perplexed at this statement, and kept pondering what kind of salutation this was. **30** The angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary; for you have found favor with God. **31** And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a **son**, and **you shall name Him Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; 33 and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end.”**

Luke 2:10,11 “But the angel said to them, ‘Do not be afraid; for behold, **I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people; 11 for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Messiah the Lord.”**

The King Secures His Kingdom

Matthew 16:15-18 “He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?”
16 Simon Peter answered, ‘**You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.**’ **17** And Jesus said to him, “Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. **18** I also say to you that you are Peter, and **upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.”**

Matthew 13:41,42 “**The Son of Man** will send forth His angels, and **they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who commit lawlessness,** **42** and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.”

The King Protects His Servants

John 10:9 **“I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and **find pasture.**”**

John 10:11-13 **“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. **12** The hired hand is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. **13** **The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.**”**

John 17:12 **“While I was with them, I was keeping them in Your name** which You have given Me; and **I guarded them** and not one of them perished but the son of perdition, so that the Scripture would be fulfilled.”

John 17:15 **“I do not ask You to take them out of the world, but to keep them from the evil one.”**

The King Delegates Authority

Matthew 10:5-8 “These twelve Jesus sent out after instructing them: ‘Do not go in the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter any city of the Samaritans; **6** but rather go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. **7** And as you go, preach, saying, **“The kingdom of heaven is at hand.”** **8** Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons. **Freely you received, freely give.”**

Matthew 16:19 **“I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven;** and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven.”

The King Administers Justice

1 Corinthians 4:5 “Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, but wait **until the Lord comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of men’s hearts**; and then each man’s praise will come to him from God.”

Revelations 20:11,12 “Then I saw **a great white throne and Him who sat upon it**, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. **12** And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, **and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.**”

The King Rightly Orders Society

Matthew 4:10 "Then Jesus said to him, 'Go, Satan! For it is written, **"You shall worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only."**"

Matthew 5-7 Sermon on the Mount

Matthew 22:36-40 "'Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?' **37** And He said to him, '**You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.**' **38 This is the great and foremost commandment. 39 The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'** **40** On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.'"

The King Manages the Royal Treasury

Matthew 6:19-21 “**Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth,** where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. **20 But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven,** where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”**

Matthew 22:21 “They said to Him, ‘Caesar’s.’ Then He said to them, “Then render to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s; and **to God the things that are God’s.”**

The King Maintains Domestic Peace

Mark 9:50 "Salt is good; but if the salt becomes unsalty, with what will you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, **and be at peace with one another.**"

Luke 19:37,38 "As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles which they had seen, **38** shouting: '**Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!**'"

John 14:27 "'**Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you.** Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.'"

The King Makes War Upon His Enemies

Luke 19:12-15,26,27 "So He said, '**A man of noble birth went to a distant country to receive a kingdom for himself**, and then return. **13** And he called ten of his slaves, and gave them ten *minas* and said to them, "Do business with this until I come back." **14** **But his citizens hated him and sent a delegation after him, saying, "We do not want this man to reign over us."** **15** When he returned, after receiving the kingdom, he ordered that these slaves, to whom he had given the money, be called to him so that he might know what business they had done...**26** I tell you that to everyone who has, more shall be given, but from the one who does not have, even what he does have shall be taken away. **27** **But these enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, bring them here and slay them in my presence."**

The King Makes War Upon His Enemies

Matthew 22:41-45 “Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question: **42** ‘**What do you think about the Messiah, whose son is He?**’ They said to Him, ‘**The son of David.**’ **43** He said to them, ‘Then how does David in the Spirit call Him ‘Lord,’ saying, **44** “The Lord said to my Lord, ‘**Sit at My right hand, until I put Your enemies beneath Your feet?**””

Matthew 25:41-43 “Then [the King] will also say to those on His left, “**Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels;** **42** for I was hungry, and you gave Me nothing to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me nothing to drink; **43** I was a stranger, and you did not invite Me in; naked, and you did not clothe Me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit Me.””

Jesus' Authority over His Life

John 10:14-18 "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me— **15** just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and **I lay down my life for the sheep.** **16** I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd. **17** The reason my Father loves me is that **I lay down my life—only to take it up again.** **18** No one takes it from me, but **I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."**

John 19:10,11 "So Pilate said to Him, 'You do not speak to me? Do You not know that I have authority to release You, and I have authority to crucify You?' **11** **Jesus answered, 'You would have no authority over Me, unless it had been given you from above;** for this reason he who delivered Me to you has the greater sin.'"

Jesus' Authority over Demons

Matthew 8:28-32 "When He came to the other side into the country of the Gadarenes, **two men who were demon-possessed** met Him as they were coming out of the tombs. They were so extremely violent that no one could pass by that way. **29 And they cried out, saying, 'What business do we have with each other, Son of God? Have You come here to torment us before the time?'** **30** Now there was a herd of many swine feeding at a distance from them. **31** The demons began to entreat Him, saying, 'If You are going to cast us out, send us into the herd of swine.' **32 And He said to them, 'Go!' And they came out and went into the swine, and the whole herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea and perished in the waters."**

Jesus' Authority over Serpents

Luke 10:19 “Behold, **I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and authority over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you.”**

Romans 16:20 “**The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet**. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.”

Revelations 12:9 “**And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth**, and his angels were cast out with him.”

Jesus' Authority over Nature

Mark 4:35-41 "On that day, when evening came, He said to them, Let us go over to the other side.' **36** Leaving the crowd, they took Him along with them in the boat, just as He was; and other boats were with Him. **37** And there arose a fierce gale of wind, and the waves were breaking over the boat so much that the boat was already filling up. **38** Jesus Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke Him and said to Him, 'Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?' **39** **And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, 'Hush, be still.' And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm.** **40** And He said to them, 'Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?' **41** They became very much afraid and said to one another, '**Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?**'"

Jesus' Authority over the Law

Matthew 5:43-45 “You have heard that it was said, “You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.” 44 But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for He causes His sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous.”

Matthew 5:17 “Do not think that I came to abolish **the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill.”**

Jesus' Authority over the Temple

Matthew 12:3-6 "But He said to them, 'Have you not read what David did when he became hungry, he and his companions, **4** how he entered the house of God, and they ate the consecrated bread, which was not lawful for him to eat nor for those with him, but for the priests alone? **5** Or have you not read in the Law, that on the Sabbath the priests in the temple break the Sabbath and are innocent? **6** **But I say to you that something greater than the temple is here.**'"

Luke 19:45,46 "**Jesus entered the temple and began to drive out those who were selling,** **46** saying to them, 'It is written, "And My house shall be a house of prayer," but you have made it a robbers' den.'"

John 2:19 "Jesus answered them, '**Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.**'"

Jesus' Authority over Our Lives

John 13:13 **“You call Me Teacher and Lord;** and you are right, for so I am.”

Romans 14:8–9 **“For if we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's.** 9 For to this end Christ died and lived again, that he might be Lord both of the dead and of the living.”

John 10:27 **“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and **they follow Me**”**

Jesus' Authority over our Sin

Matthew 28:18 "And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.'"

Luke 5:24 "'But, so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins,'—He said to the paralytic—'I say to you, get up, and pick up your stretcher and go home.'"

Luke 7:47,48 "'For this reason I say to you, **her sins, which are many, have been forgiven,** for she loved much; but he who is forgiven little, loves little.' **48** Then He said to her, '**Your sins have been forgiven.**'"

Jesus' Authority over Sanctification

John 13:10 "Jesus said to him, 'He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.'"

1 Corinthians 1:30 "But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, **who became to us** wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption"

Mark 7:17-19 "When he had left the crowd and entered the house, His disciples questioned Him about the parable. **18** And He said to them, 'Are you so lacking in understanding also? Do you not understand that whatever goes into the man from outside cannot defile him, **19** because it does not go into his heart, but into his stomach, and is eliminated?'"
(**Thus He declared all foods clean.**)

Jesus' Authority over Sickness

Matthew 9:27-30 "As Jesus went on from there, **two blind men followed Him, crying out, 'Have mercy on us, Son of David!'** **28** When He entered the house, the blind men came up to Him, and Jesus said to them, 'Do you believe that I am able to do this?' They said to Him, 'Yes, Lord.' **29** Then He touched their eyes, saying, **'It shall be done to you according to your faith.'** **30** And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them: 'See that no one knows about this!'"

Mark 2:9-12 "'Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven'; or to say, 'Get up, and pick up your pallet and walk'? **10** But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins'—He said to the paralytic, **11** 'I say to you, get up, pick up your pallet and go home.' **12** **And he got up and immediately picked up the pallet and went out in the sight of everyone, so that they were all amazed and were glorifying God, saying, 'We have never seen anything like this.'**

Jesus' Authority over Death

John 5:25 "Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when **the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.**"

John 11:21-27 "Martha then said to Jesus, 'Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. **22** Even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You.' **23** Jesus said to her, 'Your brother will rise again.' **24** Martha said to Him, 'I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day.' **25 Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?**' **27** She said to Him, 'Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world.'"

Jesus' Authority over Abraham's Seed

John 8:37-44 **“I know that you are Abraham’s descendants** [lit. ‘seed’]; yet you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you. **38** I speak the things which I have seen with **My Father**; therefore you also do the things which you heard **from your father.**’ **39** They answered and said to Him, ‘Abraham is our father.’ Jesus said to them, **‘If you are Abraham’s children, do the deeds of Abraham.** **40** But as it is, you are seeking to kill Me, a man who has told you the truth, which I heard from God; this Abraham did not do. **41** **You are doing the deeds of your father.**’ They said to Him, ‘We were not born of fornication; we have one Father: God.’ **42** Jesus said to them, **‘If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and have come from God,** for I have not even come on My own initiative, but He sent Me. **43** Why do you not understand what I am saying? It is because you cannot hear My word. **44** **You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father.** He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature, for he is a liar and the father of lies.”



The Kingdom Not of This World

Mark 1:14,15 “Now after John had been taken into custody, Jesus came into Galilee, **preaching the gospel of God, 15** and saying, ‘The time is fulfilled, and **the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel.**’”

John 18:36 “Jesus answered, ‘**My kingdom is not of this world. If my kingdom were of this world, my servants **would have been fighting**, that I might not be delivered over to the Jews. But my kingdom is not from the world.**’”

The King First Must Suffer in Rejection

Luke 17:20-25 “Now having been questioned by the Pharisees as to when the kingdom of God was coming, He answered them and said, **‘The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed; 21 nor will they say, “Look, here it is!” or, “There it is!” For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst.’ 22** And He said to the disciples, **‘The days will come when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, and you will not see it. 23** They will say to you, “Look there! Look here!” Do not go away, and do not run after them. **24** For just like the lightning, when it flashes out of one part of the sky, shines to the other part of the sky, **so will the Son of Man be in His day. 25 But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation.’”**

The Son of Man Given Eternal Kingdom

Daniel 7:13,14 "I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven **One like a Son of Man** was coming, and He came up to the Ancient of Days and was presented before Him. **14 And to Him was given dominion, glory and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations and men of every language might serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion which will not pass away, and His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed.**"

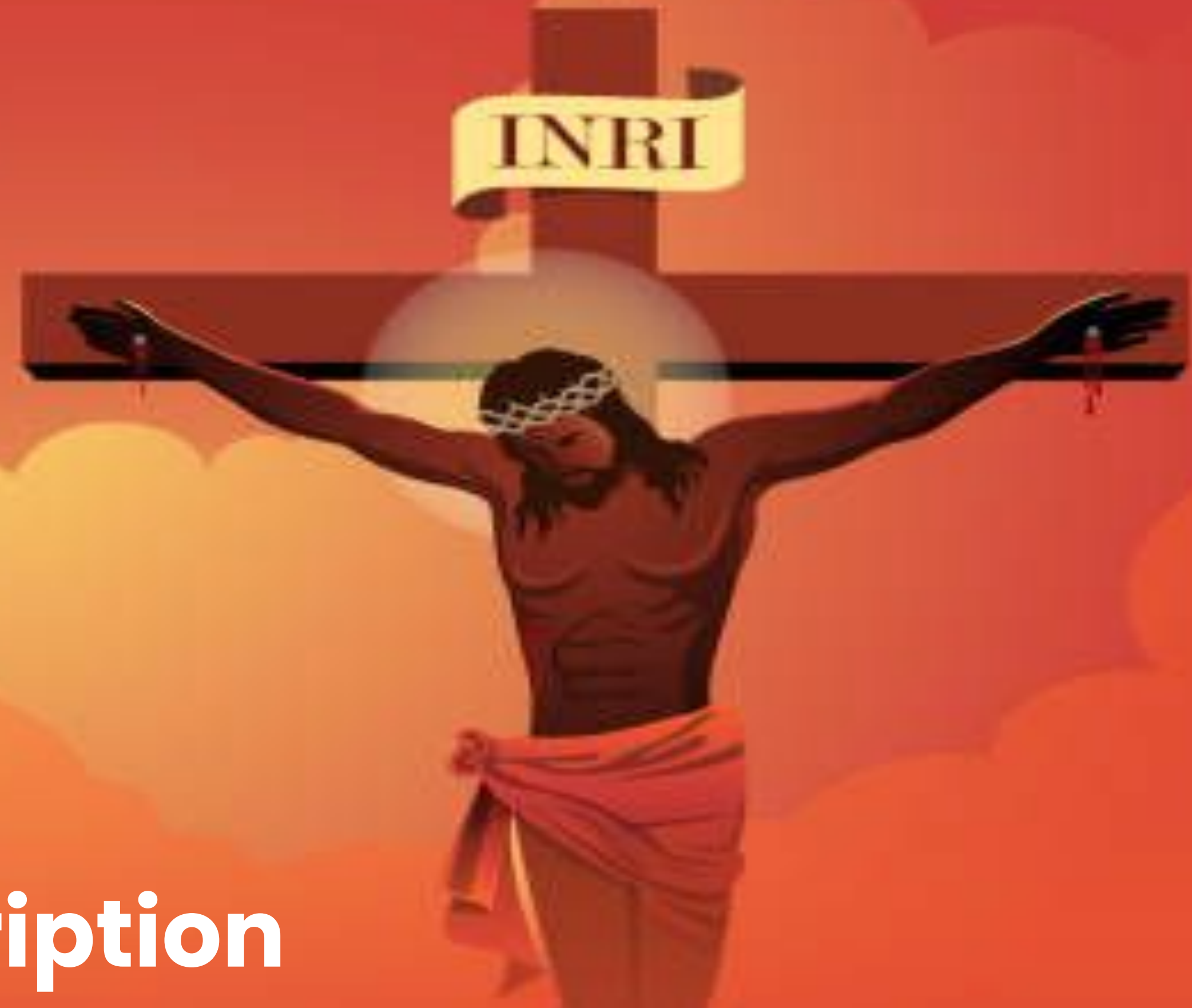

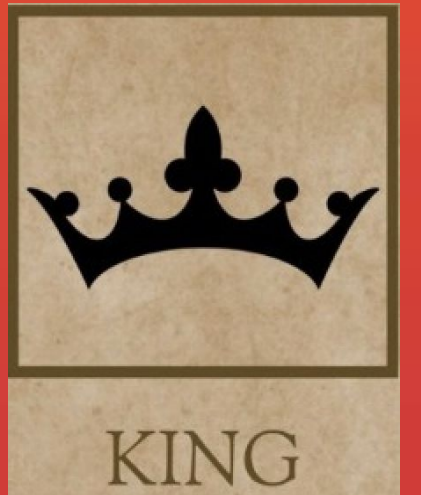

Gospel Promised Through Prophets

Luke 1:67-79, "And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Spirit, and prophesied, saying: **68** 'Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, for He has visited us and accomplished redemption for His people, **69** and has raised up a horn of salvation for us In the house of David His servant. **70** **As He spoke by the mouth of His holy prophets from of old—** **71** salvation from our enemies, and from the hand of all who hate us. **72** To show mercy toward our fathers, and to remember His holy covenant, **73** the oath which He swore to Abraham our father. **74** To grant us that we, being rescued from the hand of our enemies, might serve Him without fear, **75** in holiness and righteousness before Him all our days. **76** And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High, for you will go on before the LORD to prepare His ways, **77** to give to His people the knowledge of salvation by the forgiveness of their sins. **78** Because of the tender mercy of our God, with which the Sunrise from on high will visit us, **79** to shine upon those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.'"

The Gospel According to Zacharias

1. God accomplished redemption for His people (Luke 1:68)
2. Jesus is God's savior from the House of David (v.69)
3. God's promises through the prophets have been fulfilled in Christ (v. 70)
4. Jesus delivers from enemies (vv. 71,74)
5. The Patriarchs still live for God shows mercy to them (v. 72)
6. Christ's birth brings fellowship with God in "holiness and righteousness" (v. 75)
7. His son, John, is to be in the spirit and power of "Elijah the prophet" sent to prepare Israel as a people for Christ (v. 76)
8. Jesus is the long awaited God Messiah (v. 76)
9. Jesus has the power to forgive sins (v. 77)
10. Jesus is the light to the Gentiles foretold (v. 79)

Old Testament Promises

The Gospel Promise of the King of Kings



1. Satan ultimately will be **crushed** by the Skull Crusher from Seed of the Woman (*Genesis 3:15*)
2. This victory over Satan will only be possible through the **suffering** of the Skull Crusher (*Genesis 3:15*)
3. Through a **descendant** of Abraham, Isaac & Jacob all nations of the earth were to be **blessed** (*Genesis 12:3, etc.*)
4. "Shiloh", one from the **tribe of Judah**, will be a **King of Kings** and **Rest-bringer** (*Genesis 49:10*)
5. The King of Kings would introduce a time of great **abundance** (*Genesis 49:11-12*)
6. From the **clan of Bethlehem Ephrathah** will go forth a **ruler** in Israel for the LORD (*Micah 5:2*)
7. David's house and kingdom shall **endure before God forever** (*2 Samuel 7:16*)
8. A **virgin** will bear a **son**, "**Immanuel**", (*Isaiah 7:14*), a King from David's lineage will be called "**Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace**" whose eternal rule brings ever-increasing **worldwide justice** (*Isaiah 9:6,7*)
9. The **Spirit of LORD** will rest upon Jesse's heir: the spirit of wisdom, counsel, strength, understanding, knowledge & fear of the LORD (*Isaiah 11:1,2*)
10. Jesse's heir will rule and **judge in righteousness & faith** (*Isaiah 11:4,5*)

Jesus Fulfills All Gospel Promises



1. Jesus **"crushes"** the serpent (Romans 16:20; Revelation 20)
2. **God "appointed" Christ** as universal heir (Luke 2:24; Hebrews 3:2)
3. **Men to "call upon Jesus"** for salvation (Acts 2:21, 4:12; Romans 10:13; 2 Timothy 2:19)
4. Jesus gives **"rest"** to Mankind (Matthew 11:28-30; Hebrews 4:1-11)
5. Jesus is the eternal Word made flesh who **"tabernacled among us"** (John 1:14)
6. God has formed **"a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation"** from Jesus (1 Peter 2:9)
7. God gives us every spiritual **"blessing"** in Christ (Matthew 5:3-11; Acts 3:26; Ephesians 1:3)
8. God established an **"eternal covenant"** through Jesus (2 Corinthians 3:6; Hebrews 13:20)
9. **A great multitude that no one could number** worships Christ as LORD (Revelation 7:9)
10. Jesus promises to **never leave his sheep** (Matthew 28:20; Luke 15:4; 19:10)
11. Jesus' **obedience** brings righteousness to many (Romans 1:4,5; 5:19; Hebrews 5:9; 1 Peter 1:2)
12. God selected **Jesus as King** and **heir over all things** (Luke 1:32,33; Hebrews 1:2-8)
13. Jesus born in **Bethlehem** as **ruler** (Matthew 2:6; Luke 2:4,11; John 7:42)
14. Jesus sits on **throne of David**, reigning over an **eternal kingdom** (Luke 1:32-33; Hebrews 1:8)
15. The **Holy Spirit of righteousness rests upon Jesus** (John 1:32-33; Ephesians 1:17; 1 Corinthians 1:30)
16. Jesus was **born of a virgin, God incarnate, King of Kings**, who dwells among us (**Immanuel**) and whose **spirit lives in us** (Matthew 1:23; John 1:1-18; Romans 8:9; Ephesians 2:14-18; Hebrews 13:20; Revelation 17:14; 19:16)

The Spirit-Filled Righteous King



Isaiah 11:1-5 (*cf. Jer. 23:5,6; 33:15,16*) “**Then a shoot will spring from the stem of Jesse, and a branch from his roots will bear fruit. **2** The Spirit of the LORD [1] will rest on Him, the spirit of wisdom [2] and understanding [3], the spirit of counsel [4] and strength [5], the spirit of knowledge [6] and the fear of the LORD [7]. **3** And He will delight in the fear of the LORD, And He will not judge by what His eyes see, nor make a decision by what His ears hear; **4** **But with righteousness He will judge the poor, and decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth. And He will strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He will slay the wicked. **5** Also righteousness will be the belt about His loins, and faithfulness the belt about His waist.”****

Messiah is The Lord Our Righteousness

Jeremiah 23:5,6 “Behold, the days are coming,” declares the LORD, when **I will raise up for David a righteous Branch; and He will reign as king and act wisely and do justice and righteousness in the land. 6** “In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel **will dwell securely**; and this is His name by which He will be called, **‘The LORD our righteousness.’”**

The Righteous King

Psalm 7 *A Psalm of Solomon* “**Give the king Your judgments, O God, and Your righteousness to the king’s son. 2** May he judge Your people with righteousness, and Your afflicted with justice. **3** Let the mountains bring peace to the people, and the hills, by righteousness. **4** May he vindicate the afflicted of the people, save the children of the needy and crush the oppressor. **5** Let them fear You while the sun endures, and as long as the moon, throughout all generations. **6** May he come down like rain upon the mown grass, like showers that water the earth. **7** In his days may the righteous flourish, and abundance of peace till the moon is no more. **8** **May he also rule from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. 9** Let the nomads of the desert bow before him, and his enemies lick the dust.”

A King of Kings Comes from Judah

Genesis 49:8-12 **“Judah, your brothers shall praise you; your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies;** your father's sons shall bow down before you. **9** Judah is a lion's cub; from the prey, my son, you have gone up. He stooped down; he crouched as a lion and as a lioness; who dares rouse him? **10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until [Shiloh] tribute comes to him; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples** [nations]. **11** Binding his foal to the vine and his donkey's colt to the choice vine, he has washed his garments in wine and his vesture in the blood of grapes. **12** His eyes are darker than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk.”

The Eternal King of Peace from Bethlehem

Micah 5:2–5a “But as for you, **Bethlehem Ephrathah, too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you One will go forth for Me to be ruler in Israel. His goings forth are from long ago, From the days of eternity.**’ **3** Therefore He will give them up until the time **When she who is in labor has borne a child.** Then the remainder of His brethren will return to the sons of Israel. **4** **And He will arise and shepherd His flock In the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD His God.** And they will remain, because at that time He will be great to the ends of the earth. **5** **This One will be our peace.**”

The Everlasting King on David's Throne

Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the LORD Himself will give you a sign: **Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel** ['God with us']."

Isaiah 9:6,7 "'For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us. And the government will rest on His shoulders, and His name will be called **Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. 7 There will be no end to the increase of His government nor of peace, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and **forevermore**. The zeal of the LORD of Hosts will accomplish this.'"**

The Eternal House of David

Psalm 89:20-29 **“I have found David My servant; with My holy oil I have anointed him. 21** Whom with My hand will be established; My arm also will strengthen him. **22 The enemy will not deceive him, nor the son of wickedness afflict him. 23 But I shall crush his adversaries before him, and strike those who hate him. 24** My faithfulness and My lovingkindness will be with him, and in My name his horn will be exalted. **25** I shall also set his hand on the sea and his right hand on the rivers. **26 He will cry to Me, ‘You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation.’ 27 I also shall make him My firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth. 28** My lovingkindness I will keep for him forever, and My covenant shall be confirmed to him. **29 So I will establish his descendants forever and his throne as the days of heaven.”**

David's Kingdom Blessing

2 Samuel 7:8-17 “Now therefore, thus you shall say to **My servant David**, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts, “I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, **to be ruler over My people Israel.** **9** I have been with you wherever you have gone and have cut off all your enemies from before you; and **I will make you a great name, like the names of the great men who are on the earth.** **10** I will also appoint a place for My people Israel and will plant them, that they may live in their own place and not be disturbed again, nor will the wicked afflict them any more as formerly, **11** even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel; and **I will give you rest from all your enemies. The Lord also declares to you that the LORD will make a house for you.** **12** When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, **I will raise up your descendant after you, who will come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom.** **13** He shall build a house for My name, and **I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.** **14** I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I will correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men, **15** but My lovingkindness shall not depart from him, as I took it away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. **16 Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever.’** **17** In accordance with all these words and all this vision, so Nathan spoke to David.”
