

The Lamb of God Throughout the Bible

Behold! The Lamb of God

John 1:29 "The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, 'Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

1 Peter 1:18,19 "Knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ."

1 Corinthians 5:7 "Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."

Revelation 5:13 "And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them, I heard saying, 'To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever."

Revelation 13:8 "And all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the **Lamb who was slain**."

The Lamb of God Justifies

Romans 5:9 "Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him."

Justify is to declare what is right, to pronounce what is correct and in accordance with the truth

The Lamb of God Redeems & Purifies

Titus 2:11-14 "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, 12 instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, 13 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, 14 who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds."

Redemption is the action of buying back or repurchasing what was previously forfeited or lost.

Purify is the action of cleansing from stain & defilement

The Lamb of God Ransoms

Matthew 20:25–28 "But Jesus called them to Himself and said, 'You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them. 26 It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant, 27 and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave; 28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a <u>ransom</u> for many."

Ransom ia a price paid to secure the freedom of a slave or to set free from liabilities and charges, and generally the deliverance from calamity by paying the forfeit.

The Lamb of God Cleanses

1 John 1:7 "But if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son <u>cleanses</u> us from all sin."

Hebrews 9:13,14 "For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, 14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, <u>cleanse</u> your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"

Cleanse is to make pure from all defilement

The Lamb of God Brings Peace

Colossians 1:19,20 "For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, 20 and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

Peace is wholeness, harmony, the absence of conflict

The Lamb of God Grants Access

Ephesians 2:13 "But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ."

Brought near is access to God, to make one able to approach the throne of God

The Lamb of God Offers Communion

1 Corinthians 10:16 "Is not the cup of blessing which we bless a <u>sharing</u> in the blood of Christ? Is not the bread which we break a <u>sharing</u> in the body of Christ?"

Sharing is fellowship, communion, participation and partnership

The Lamb of God Substitutes

Ephesians 5:1,2 "Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; **2** and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and **gave Himself up <u>for us</u>**, an **offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.**"

Substitute is one who, or that which, is substituted or put in the place of another; one who acts for another; that which stands in place of something else

The Lamb of God Overcomes

Revelation 12:10,11 "Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night. 11 And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced

Overcome is to carry off victory, to subdue and prevail

The Lamb of God Reconciles

Romans 5:10 "For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life."

Reconcile is to cause to be friendly again, to restore to friendship; to bring back to harmony; to cause to be no longer at variancea change from enmity to friendship. It is mutual, i.e., it is a change wrought in both parties who have been at enmity.

The Lamb of God Propitiates [Atones]

Romans 3:21-35 "But now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; 25 whom God displayed publicly as a <u>propitiation</u> in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed."


Propitiate [atone] is the act of appeasing the wrath and making amends for the favor of an offended person, to remove guilt

The Spotless Lamb of God


- 1. Christ claimed to be absolutely sinless. (John 8:46)
- 2. He prayed, but He never prayed for personal forgiveness.
- 3. He interceded on behalf of His disciples but He never exhorted them to intercede for Him.
- 4. He was often in the Temple, but He never offered sacrifice for Himself.
- 5. He was conscious of the sin of others, but not of any personal sin.
- 6. He never corrected those nearest to Him who believed He was sinless.
- 7. He sorrowed for the sin of the world, but He never sorrowed for His own sin.
- 8. He taught that all need to be born again, but He never hinted that He was born again, or that He needed such a change.
- 9. He was explicitly declared by the apostolic witnesses to be sinless (Heb. 4:15, 1 Peter 2:22; 2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 John 3:5)

The Provision & Extent of the Lamb of God

- 1. Christ died for all (2 Corinthians 5:15)
- 2. He tasted death for every man (Hebrews 2:9)
- 3. God so loved the world that He gave His only Son to save the world through him (John 3:16-18)
- 4. The Lamb of God took away the sins of the world (John 1:29; John 4:42)
- 5. Christ made justification available for all (Romans 5:18-20)
- 6. The Gospel is available and to be preached to every creature (Mark 16:15; Matthew 28:18-20; Revelation 22:17)
- 7. God is not willing that any should perish (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9)
- 8. God is no respector of persons (Romans 2:11; Acts 10:34-35)
- 9. Christ is the propitiation for the sins of the whole world (1 John 2:2; 4:10)

1. Sacrifice these two animals to atone for the sins of the high priest and his family:




4. Burn incense in the Most Holy Place and sprinkle the blood of the previous animal sacrifices onto the Ark of the Covenant.




2. Get two goats. Choose one to be a scapegoat to bear the sins of the community. The other goat will be sacrificed.



5. The high priest is to verbally transfer the sins of the community onto the scapegoat.



3. Sacrifice these two animals to atone for the sins of the community:



6. A man will then lead the scapegoat far into the desert and abandon it to die.





Leviticus 16:21,22


"Then Aaron shall lay both of his hands on the head of the live goat, and confess over it all the iniquities of the sons of Israel and all their transgressions in regard to all their sins; and he shall lay them on the head of the goat and send it away into the wilderness by the hand of a man who stands in readiness. 22 The goat shall bear on itself all their iniquities to a solitary land; and he shall release the goat in the wilderness."


