The Gospel Promise of the King of Kings



1. Satan ultimately will be crushed by the Skull Crusher from Seed of the Woman (*Genesis 3:15*)
2. This victory over Satan will only be possible through the suffering of the Skull Crusher (*Genesis 3:15*)
3. Through a descendant of Abraham, Isaac & Jacob all nations of the earth were to be blessed (*Genesis 12:3, etc.*)
4. **“Shiloh”, one from the tribe of Judah, will be a King of Kings and Rest-bringer (*Genesis 49:10*)**
5. The King of Kings would introduce a time of great abundance (*Genesis 49:11-12*)
6. From the clan of Bethlehem Ephrathah will go forth a ruler in Israel for the LORD (*Micah 5:2*)
7. **David’s house and kingdom shall endure before God forever (*2 Samuel 7:16*)**
8. **A virgin will bear a son, “Immanuel”, (*Isaiah 7:14*), a King from David’s lineage will be called “Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace” whose eternal rule brings ever-increasing worldwide justice (*Isaiah 9:6,7*)**

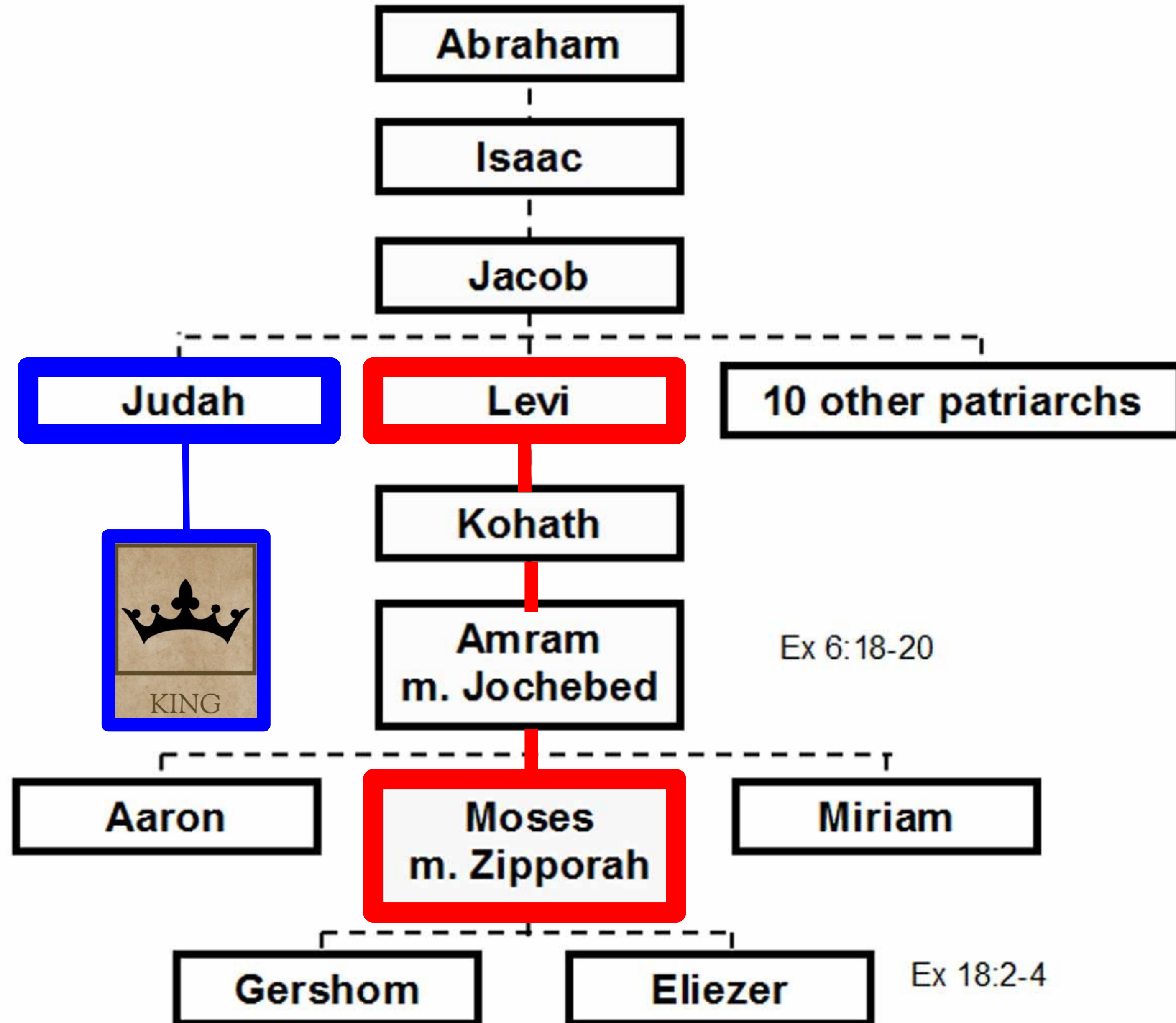

Moses the Deliverer from Bondage

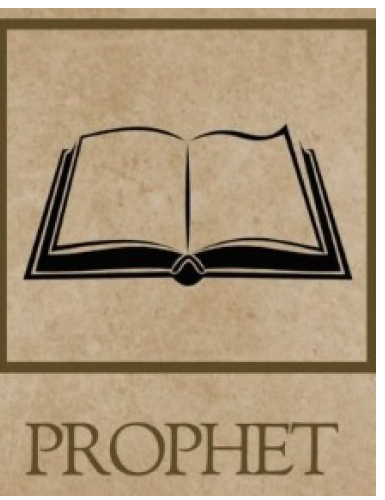
Exodus 2:23,24 “Now it came about in the course of those many days that the king of Egypt died. **And the sons of Israel sighed because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry for help because of their bondage rose up to God. 24** So God heard their groaning; and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.”

Exodus 3:9,10 “Now, behold, the cry of the sons of Israel has come to Me; furthermore, I have seen the oppression with which the Egyptians are oppressing them. **10 Therefore, come now, and I will send you to Pharaoh, so that you may bring My people, the sons of Israel, out of Egypt.**”

Exodus 3:14 **God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM”; and He said, “Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”**



Moses the Faithful Prophet



Exodus 4:12 “Now then go, and **I, even I, will be with your mouth**, and teach you what you are to say.”

Exodus 4:15,16 “You are to speak to Aaron and put the words in his mouth; **and I, even I, will be with your mouth and his mouth**, and I will teach you what you are to do. **16** Moreover, he shall speak for you to the people; and **he will be as a mouth for you and you will be as God to him.**”

Numbers 12:6-8a “The LORD said, ‘Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, I, the LORD, shall make Myself known to him in a vision. I shall speak with him in a dream. **7 Not so, with My servant Moses: He is faithful in all My household.** **8 With him I speak mouth to mouth**, even openly, and not in dark sayings, and he beholds the form of the LORD.’”

The LORD Will Provide for Himself the Lamb

Genesis 22:6-14 “Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son, and he took in his hand the fire and the knife. So the two of them walked on together. **7** Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, **“My father!”** And he said, **“Here I am, my son.”** And he said, “Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?” **8** Abraham said, **“God will provide for Himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son.”** So the two of them walked on together. **9** Then they came to the place of which God had told him; and Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood, and bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. **10** Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. **11** But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, “Abraham, Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.” **12** He said, “Do not stretch out your hand against the lad, and do nothing to him; for now **I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me.**” **13** Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him **a ram** caught in the thicket by his horns; and **Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son.** **14** Abraham called the name of that place **The LORD Will Provide**, as it is said to this day, **“In the mount of the LORD it will be provided.”**

Moses and the Passover Lamb

Exodus 12:21-27 “Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, “Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families, and slay the Passover lamb. **22 You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts;** and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning. **23** For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to come in to your houses to smite you. **24 And you shall observe this event as an ordinance for you and your children forever.** **25** When you enter the land which the LORD will give you, as He has promised, you shall observe this rite. **26** And when your children say to you, ‘What does this rite mean to you?’ **27** you shall say, ‘It is a Passover sacrifice to the LORD who passed over the houses of the sons of Israel in Egypt when He smote the Egyptians, but spared our homes.’” And the people bowed low and worshiped.”



Moses the Shepherd

Exodus 15:1-8 “Then Moses and the sons of Israel sang this song to the LORD, and said, **“I will sing to the LORD, for He is highly exalted; the horse and its rider He has hurled into the sea. 2 The LORD is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation;** This is my God, and I will praise Him; My father’s God, and I will extol Him. **3** The LORD is a warrior; The LORD is His name. **4** **“Pharaoh’s chariots and his army He has cast into the sea; And the choicest of his officers are drowned in the Red Sea. 5 The deeps cover them; they went down into the depths like a stone. 6 Your right hand, O LORD, is majestic in power; Your right hand, O LORD, shatters the enemy. 7** And in the greatness of Your excellence You overthrow those who rise up against You; You send forth Your burning anger, and it consumes them as chaff. **8** At the blast of Your nostrils the waters were piled up, **the flowing waters stood up like a heap; The deeps were congealed in the heart of the sea.;”**



Moses the Covenant Mediator

Exodus 20:18–21 “All the people perceived the thunder and the lightning flashes and the sound of the trumpet and the mountain smoking; **and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood at a distance. 19** Then they said to Moses, ‘**Speak to us yourself and we will listen; but let not God speak to us, or we will die.**’ **20** Moses said to the people, ‘Do not be afraid; for God has come in order to test you, and **in order that the fear of Him may remain with you, so that you may not sin.**’ **21** **So the people stood at a distance, while Moses approached the thick cloud where God was.**”

Exodus 34:1–4 “Now the LORD said to Moses, ‘**Cut out for yourself two stone tablets like the former ones, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the former tablets which you shattered. 2** **So be ready by morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to Me on the top of the mountain. 3** **No man is to come up with you, nor let any man be seen anywhere on the mountain;** even the flocks and the herds may not graze in front of that mountain.” **4** So he cut out two stone tablets like the former ones, and Moses rose up early in the morning and went up to Mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and he took two stone tablets in his hand.”







Moses the Law Giver

Exodus 34:29–35 “It came about when Moses was coming down from Mount Sinai (and the two tablets of the testimony were in Moses’ hand as he was coming down from the mountain), that Moses did not know that **the skin of his face shone because of his speaking with Him.** **30** So when Aaron and all the sons of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him. **31** Then Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the rulers in the congregation returned to him; and Moses spoke to them. **32** Afterward all the sons of Israel came near, and he commanded them to do everything that the LORD had spoken to him on Mount Sinai. **33** When Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face. **34** But whenever Moses went in before the LORD to speak with Him, **he would take off the veil until he came out;** and whenever he came out and spoke to the sons of Israel what he had been commanded, **35** the sons of Israel would see the face of Moses, that **the skin of Moses’ face shone.** So Moses would replace the veil over his face until he went in to speak with Him.”

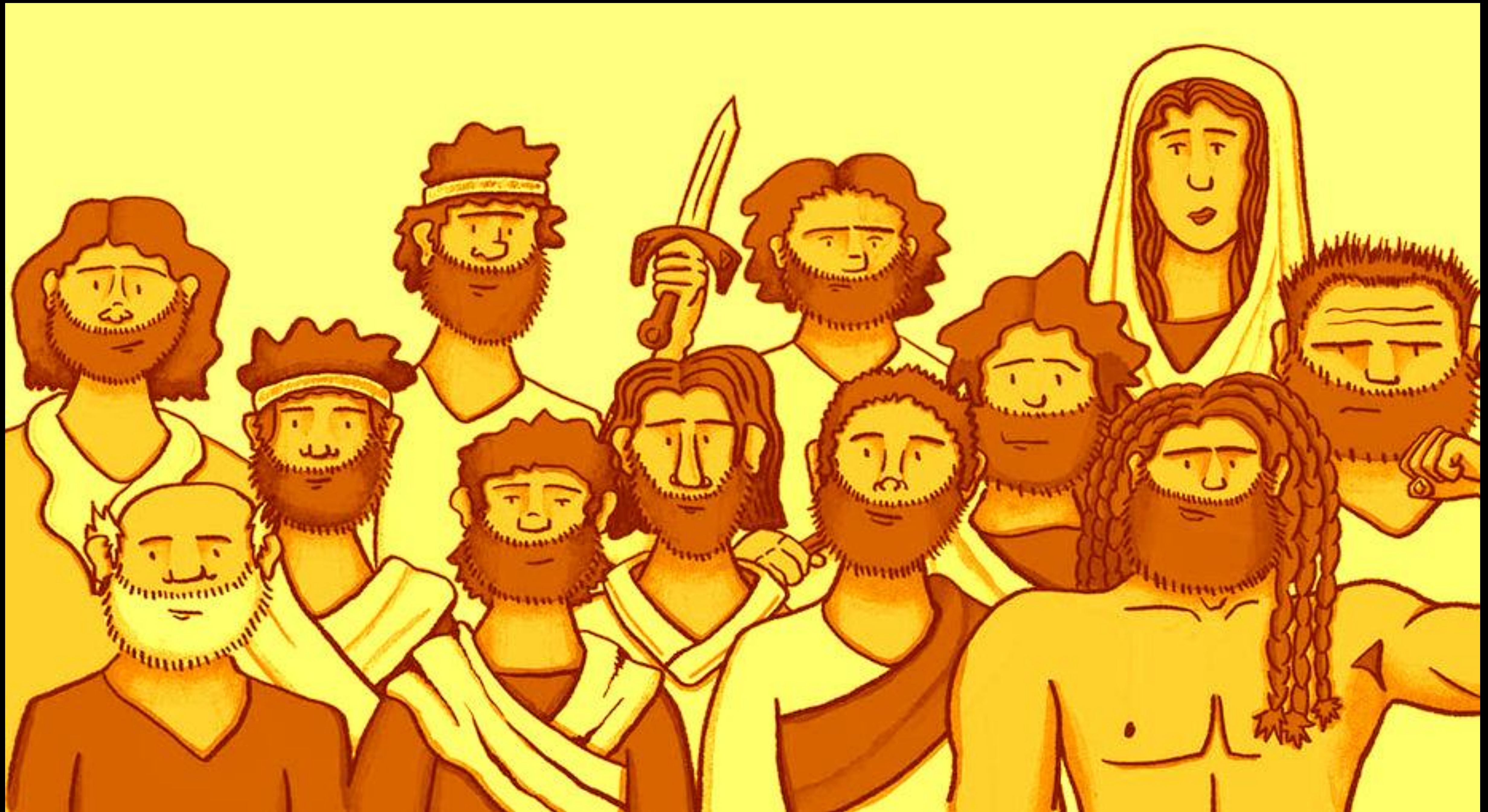

Moses the Intercessor

Exodus 32:30–32 “On the next day Moses said to the people, “You yourselves have committed a great sin; and now I am going up to the LORD, perhaps I can make atonement for your sin.” **31** Then Moses returned to the LORD, and said, “Alas, this people has committed a great sin, and they have made a god of gold for themselves. **32** **But now, if You will, forgive their sin—and if not, please blot me out from Your book which You have written!”**

Psalms 106:19–23 “They made a calf in Horeb and worshiped a molten image. **20** Thus they exchanged their glory for the image of an ox that eats grass. **21** **They forgot God their Savior**, who had done great things in Egypt, **22** wonders in the land of Ham and awesome things by the Red Sea. **23** **Therefore He said that He would destroy them, had not Moses His chosen one stood in the breach before Him, to turn away His wrath from destroying them.**”



Moses the Teacher

Deuteronomy 4:5-8 **“See, I have taught you statutes and judgments just as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do thus in the land where you are entering to possess it. 6 So keep and do them, for that is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples [nations] who will hear all these statutes and say, ‘Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.’ 7 For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as is the LORD our God whenever we call on Him? 8 Or what great nation is there that has statutes and judgments as righteous as this whole law which I am setting before you today?”**

Moses the Judge

Exodus 18:13-16 “It came about the next day that **Moses sat to judge the people,** and the people stood about Moses from the morning until the evening. **14** Now when Moses’ father-in-law saw all that he was doing for the people, he said, ‘What is this thing that you are doing for the people? Why do you alone sit as judge and all the people stand about you from morning until evening?’ **15** Moses said to his father-in-law, ‘**Because the people come to me to inquire of God. 16** When they have a dispute, it comes to me, and **I judge between a man and his neighbor and make known the statutes of God and His laws.**’”



Moses Spoke Face to Face with God

Exodus 33:7-11 “Now Moses used to take the tent and pitch it outside the camp, a good distance from the camp, and he called it the tent of meeting. And everyone who sought the LORD would go out to the tent of meeting which was outside the camp. **8** And it came about, **whenever Moses went out to the tent, that all the people would arise and stand, each at the entrance of his tent, and gaze after Moses until he entered the tent. 9 Whenever Moses entered the tent, the pillar of cloud would descend and stand at the entrance of the tent; and the LORD would speak with Moses. 10** When all the people saw the pillar of cloud standing at the entrance of the tent, all the people would arise and worship, each at the entrance of his tent. **11 Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, just as a man speaks to his friend.** When Moses returned to the camp, his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, would not depart from the tent.”

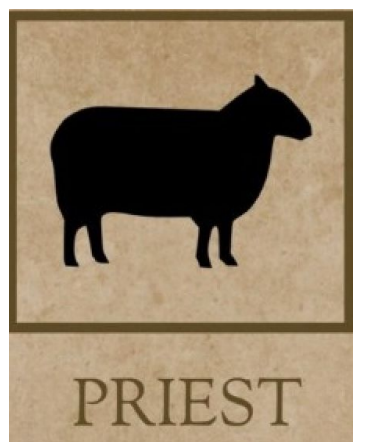
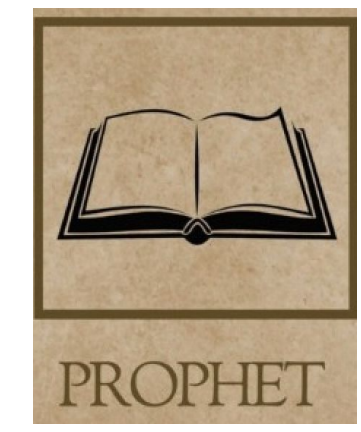


Moses the Healer

Numbers 21:6-9 “The LORD sent fiery serpents among the people and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died. **7** So the people came to Moses and said, ‘We have sinned, because we have spoken against the LORD and you; **intercede with the LORD, that He may remove the serpents from us.**’ **And Moses interceded for the people.** **8** Then the LORD said to Moses, ‘Make a fiery serpent, and **set it on a standard; and it shall come about, that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, he will live.**’ **9** And Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on the standard; and it came about, that **if a serpent bit any man, when he looked to the bronze serpent, he lived.**”



Moses the Anointing Priest



Exodus 40:9-15 “Then you shall take the anointing oil and **anoint the tabernacle and all that is in it, and shall consecrate** it and all its furnishings; and it shall be holy. **10** You shall **anoint the altar of burnt offering and all its utensils, and consecrate** the altar, and the altar shall be most holy. **11** You shall **anoint the laver and its stand, and consecrate** it. **12** Then you shall bring Aaron and his sons to the doorway of the tent of meeting and wash them with water. **13** **You shall put the holy garments on Aaron and anoint him and consecrate** him, that he may minister as a priest to Me. **14** **You shall bring his sons and put tunics on them; 15 and you shall anoint them even as you have anointed their father**, that they may minister as priests to Me; and **their anointing will qualify them for a perpetual priesthood** throughout their generations.” **16** Thus Moses did; according to all that the LORD had commanded him, so he did.”



No Prophet Like Moses in Old Testament

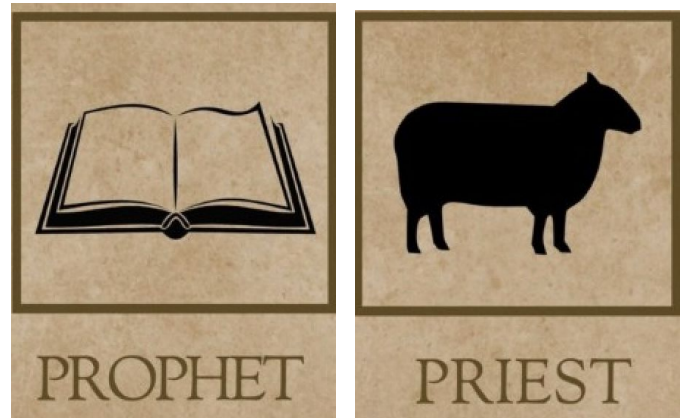
Deuteronomy 34:9-12 “Now Joshua the son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; and the sons of Israel listened to him and did as the LORD had commanded Moses. **10 Since that time no prophet has risen in Israel like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face,** **11 for all the signs and wonders which the LORD sent him to perform** in the land of Egypt against Pharaoh, all his servants, and all his land, **12 and for all the mighty power and for all the great terror which Moses performed in the sight of all Israel.”**



The Promised Prophet Like Moses

Deuteronomy 18:15–19 **““The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, you shall listen to him. 16** This is according to all that you asked of the LORD your God in Horeb on the day of the assembly, saying, ‘Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, let me not see this great fire anymore, or I will die.’ **17** The LORD said to me, ‘They have spoken well. **18** I will raise up a prophet from among their countrymen like you, and I will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. **19** It shall come about that whoever will not listen to My words which he shall speak in My name, I Myself will require it of him.””

Gospel of a 'Prophet Like Moses'



A prophet like Moses is coming who will:

1. arise from **among the people of Israel**
2. **shepherd** God's people through persecution and exile
3. **deliver** God's people from the bondage of slavery
4. **work diverse miracles and signs** in the sight of Israel and the nations
5. speak **only the words of God**
6. be **faithful in all of God's household**
7. speak **face to face with God**
8. be a godly **teacher**
9. **judge** his people according to God's Law
10. be a **covenant mediator** between sinners and a holy God
11. be a **law-giver**
12. be a miraculous **healer**
13. **build a tabernacle** where God will dwell in the midst of His people
14. be an **anointing priest** who consecrates God's tabernacle, altar, laver & priesthood
15. **intecede** to save a covenant people from God's wrath
16. be willing to **die in the place of condemned sinners**

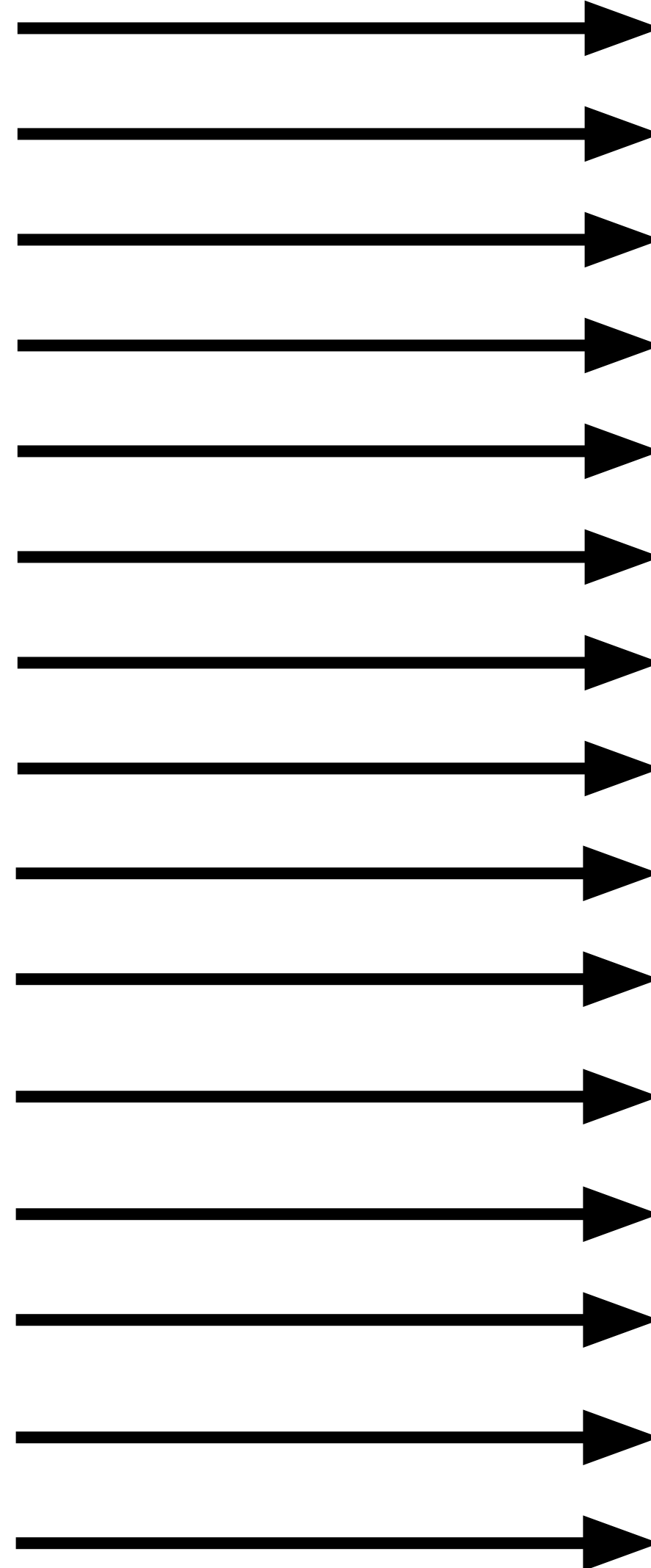
